As Mitch dims the overhead lights, he uses the remote to turn on the cart's projector. In an instant, there is a mesmerizing scene of colourful fish floating on the wall. The bubbling light tube casts a soothing, warm glow around the room. The atmosphere is immediately soothing. Mitch reaches for his cellphone to play nature sounds through the cart's Bluetooth speakers.

"I love this feature," he says. His enthusiasm is contagious. It's easy to see why the residents love him so much. "It's so amazing that I can create playlists for my residents and have them ready to go when I need them. Having music is such an important resource."

The mobile MSE carts are already making a difference —helping to ease distress, reduce agitation, and bring moments of peace to those needing extra support. Because of you, residents living with dementia are finding comfort when they need it most.
